Maintenance of Effort Allocation

The FY 2013 set aside for Maintenance of Effort allocation is equal to two times the sum of the smaller of the amounts area agencies either reported expended in the prior State FY (2011) or budgeted in the current State FY (2012). The Maintenance of Effort matching ratios is the same as it was in State FY 2001, i.e. 33% local, and 67% state or two dollars for each one dollar of match from Local Units of Government.
