Title III-D Evidence Based Requirement

Funding amount of \$179,155 for Title III Part D section 361 of the Older Americans Act for Disease Prevention and Health Promotion may only be used for programs and activities which have been demonstrated through rigorous evaluation to be evidence-based and effective. The area agency must agree to budget and expend the current fiscal year's allocation pursuant to the evidence based requirement. The area agency must at a minimum, self-certify at the lowest level, and provide a statement showing the individual programs that fulfill the evidence based requirement. Area Agency Administration Allocation - Older Americans Act

The area agency administration allocation is 10% of the state's Title III service allotments. An AAA may use only Parts B, C (1), C (2) and/or E allocations to fund the federal share of its administrative costs. However, an AAA may use only up to 10% of its part E allocation to fund its administration cost. (That is, an AAA shall not use more than 10% of its Part E allocation to fund its administration cost.)

Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP)

We recommend providers estimate NSIP revenues by multiplying the number of meals the provider plans to serve to eligible customers during FFY 2013 times \$.65 per meal. The actual FY 11 Kansas award was approximately \$.68 per meal.
