Supersedes: This IM supersedes IM 2014-02. Please use these figures for calculation of poverty starting April 1, 2015.

Notes: The guidelines include income levels for 75%, 125%, and 150% of poverty for those programs using the guidelines. Use the guidelines as criteria to classify the income of all participants receiving a service for the first time this fiscal year effective April 1, 2015.
