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Medicare Open Enrollment Assistance Offered Wednesday in Overland Park

TOPEKA – Congressman Kevin Yoder and the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services will hold a Medicare Open Enrollment Assistance event November 6 to provide help to seniors eligible to enroll during the Medicare Open Enrollment period from October 15 through December 7.

Trained volunteers with the Senior Health Insurance Counseling for Kansas (SHICK) program will be on hand to provide one-on-one assistance to seniors who have questions or who wish to make changes to their plans.

Medicare beneficiaries who wish to make changes or enroll for the first time need to bring their Medicare card, any current prescriptions (including dosage and frequency), and a list of preferred pharmacies.
