KDADS Honors Osawatomie State Hospital Employee for Outstanding Service

TOPEKA – Ashley Byram from Osawatomie State Hospital (OSH) was one of five employees from the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and the four state hospitals that were honored for exemplary service to the agency at a ceremony in the state Capitol Wednesday.

Byram received the award for Innovation and was named Employee of the Quarter at OSH. Other OSH employees cited this quarter are Scott Cook, who received the award for Meritorious Service and Kathy Gayetsky who was given an award for Distinguished Accomplishment.

This was the 4th such ceremony, part of the State employee Award and Recognition Program created by the state Legislature, to recognize the good work being done by state employees. Winners are nominated by their co-workers and supervisors at state agencies, the hospitals and other state institutions.
