

The Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) is in the process of requesting the renewal of the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Intellectual/Developmental Disability (I/DD) waiver. Requests for renewals of HCBS waivers are made to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

The HCBS - IDD provides the services needed to insure that individuals can stay in their homes and be as independent as possible in a safe, healthy environment. The HCBS-IDD program serves individuals 5 and older who meet the criteria for intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities.

Services available to individuals receiving waiver services are:

- Residential Supports
- Day Supports
- Supportive Home Care
- Respite Overnight
- Personal Assistant Services
- Supported Employment
- Sleep Cycle Support
- Specialized Medical Care (RN)
- Specialized Medical Care (LPN)
- Medical Alert Rental
- Financial Management Services
- Wellness Monitoring

KDADS is requesting renewal of this program which otherwise ends June 30, 2014.
