Older Americans Act FFY2022 Final (Annual) Financial Reports COVID-19 Guidance

<u>Measures</u>

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, flexibility has been granted for use of regular OAA funds. With that, KDADS has extended the grant periods for the FFY2021 and FFY2022 budgets in accordance with the ACL project period end dates in the table below. The project period end dates for COVID-19 awards are also included below.

Each federal fiscal year (ending September 30), KDADS is required to submit federal OAA reporting via the State Performance Report (SPR). This means that we must report OAA financial data based on all activity between **October 1, 2021 – September 30, 2022** for Federal Fiscal Year 2022(All services between Oct 2021-Sept 2022 for all award years).

<u>The Final (Annual) Financial Report that is due on December 15th, 2022 should only be</u> <u>capturing activities that occurred **between October 1, 2021 – September 30, 2022** regardless <u>of whether the entire grant has be expended.</u> Each AAA is required to provide these Final (Annual) FFY2022 Financials for all grants on the appropriate report template:</u>

- 1. OAA Individual Financials Report *(FFY2022 OAA Individual Financials)*: FFY 2020 (if applicable), 2021 and 2022 should be on one report for Admin, Title III B, C1, C2, D and E
- 2. Master Consolidated Financials OAA Template *(Master Consolidated Financials OAA Template)*: FFY 2020 (if applicable), 2021 and 2022 should be on one report for Admin, Title III B, C1, C2, D and E
- 3. COVID-19 Consolidated Financial Report Template (3.18.22 Revised_OAA-COVID19-Consolidated-Financial-Reports): FFCRA (Admin, Title III C1 and C2), CARES (Admin, Title III B, C1, C2 and E), HDC5 (Admin, Title III C2), VAC5 (Admin, Title III B)

The carryover process will not be implemented since ACL has provided an additional year to use some of these funds. As with other grants, such as Medicare, even though the contract may be multiple years, it is still required for AAAs to submit required (e.g. monthly and annual) reports on how those funds were used during that reporting period. The Final (Annual) Financial Report is being used this way to avoid creating another new reporting form.

KDADS cannot grant extensions due to federal deadlines. AAAs must submit these reports before or on December 15th, and if any corrections need to be made before December 31st, those will be accepted.
