

Kansas Youth Gambling Behavior Trend Data 2007-2012

The following report concerns adolescent gambling behavior reported by adolescents through the Kansas Communities That Care (KCTC) Student Survey. This survey is a self-report instrument for grades 6, 8, 10 and 12. The assessment is undertaken annually by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services, Community Services and Programs, Behavioral Health Services, and is used by state agencies, counties, schools, and communities in Kansas to monitor the incidence and prevalence of adolescent problem behaviors, as well as the environmental factors that put children at risk or protect them from developing problem behaviors. In 2006, questions related to problem gambling were added to the survey. This report compiles data from the 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, and 2011-12 school years.




- 1. In the past year, have you gambled for money or anything of value?
- 2. In the past 30 days, have you gambled for money or anything of value?


Responds "At Least Once"


- 3. In the past year, how many times (if any) have you: gambled at a casino?

- 7. In the past year, how many times (if any) have you: bet money on horse races?
- 8. In the past year, how many times (if any) have you: played bingo for money or prizes?
- 9. In the past year, how many times (if any) have you: gambled on the Internet?
- 10. In the past year, how many times (if any) have you: bet on dice games (such as craps)?
- 11. In the past year, how many times (if any) have you: bet on games of personal skill?














Statewide Gambling Trend Data 2007-2012
