


Q3 Rank the following factors in order of importance for community support as we age, with 1 being the highest importance (you may drag each option to rank)







## Q6 Do you need help with any of the following items in your home? (Select all that apply)





## Q9 Do you feel comfortable using technology (e.g. computer, tablet, smart phone) to receive Aging Services?



### Q10 If you use social media (e.g. Facebook), do you engage with your local Area Agency on Aging?



### Q11 In a typical month, how often do you leave your home to run errands, doctor's appointment, grocery shopping, visit others etc.?







**Q14 Select the extent to which you agree with the statement: I receive timely and helpful answers when I seek information about aging services or assistance.**



### Q15 In regards to legal assistance and services for seniors, (select all that apply)



### Q16 Did you know that fiduciary/financial abuse is a type of elder abuse and it is a serious crime in Kansas? (Select all that apply)



### Q17 Do you know how to report elder abuse? (Select all that apply)



## Q18 Overall, how would you rate your mental health?



### Q19 Select the extent to which you agree with the statement: My mental health needs are being met.







## Q22 I would like to receive nutrition education in the following manner (select all that apply)



## Q23 Select Nutrition Education topics that interest you





### Q25 If you provide care to a family member or loved one , do you feel you have the resources in your community you need to provide adequate care?



## Q26 If you are a caregiver, do you think it is important to having trainings that help with making decisions and solving problems relating to your caregiving role?










