

Determination of SED Eligibility

Course Description

This course describes how Community Mental Health Centers in Kansas determine serious emotional disturbance (SED). It helps providers understand how youth who meet specific eligibility criteria, may qualify for the special services offered through the HCBS SED Waiver or the PRTF CBA Grant.
