

Crisis Intervention

Course Description

This course focuses on increasing knowledge about Medicaid Crisis Intervention and what this service entails. The course reminds providers of the importance of maintaining clients, including clients in crisis, in the least restrictive environment appropriate for their situation. To that end, the course discusses the available community services that help maintain clients in their homes and communities. This course has been approved by the State of Kansas to fulfill the requirement of a course on Crisis Intervention.

Course Objectives
