

You may qualify for Extra Help from Medicare



What is Medicare?

Medicare is a federal health insurance program that covers:

- More than 35 million individuals ages 65 and older
- More than 6 million individuals younger than age 65 years with disabilities
- Individuals with End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)

What is Medicare Part D?

Medicare Part D* Prescription Drug Coverage:

- Insurance that covers both generic and brand-name prescriptions
- Coverage is provided through private insurance companies

*Many individuals will pay a monthly premium for Part D



Are you on a limited income? Are you having trouble paying for your medication?

Extra Help is available if:

- Your income in less than 150% of the federal poverty level*
- You have limited resources. For example, bank accounts, stocks and bonds. Your home, car and any life insurance policy do not count as resources.

*Income and resource limits change each year. Please contact your SHICK counselor for current year limits.

If you qualify for Extra Help:

- Medicare will pay for 75% or more of your prescription drug costs
- You will automatically receive help paying for:
 - Premiums
 - Deductibles
 - Co-pays of Medicare prescription drug coverage
- There is no coverage gap or late enrollment penalty
